TELL US A BIT ABOUT YOUR BACKGROUND

Michel. I started out in what could be considered possibly the most safety critical area of subsea operations, diving. have about 26 years of experience in Oil & Gas, energy and consulting industry. I have been working in different positions through the years that we could divide in 4 blocks of approximately 6 years:

- 6 years in offshore operations for e.g., BP, GDF and Shell on vessels, semi-subs, rigs and platforms, in various roles.
- Followed by 6 years within Engineering on large subsea projects globally from the Gulf of Mexico to Sahkalin and many countries in between.
- What appeared a natural step was the transition from engineering into Project management for TECHNIP, working worldwide, but residing in The United Kingdom, Norway and later Singapore. It was in Singapore that my Project management skills transformed more into an advisory capacity whilst assisting Technip in the Postacquisition of Global Industries. Part of the consulting consisted of change and integration, in addition, to materialising Shell Malikai project and further assisting in regulatory and QHSE issues on Shell Prelude in the Asia Pacific region.
- the last block has been in an Advisory role a vice President, dedicated to multi-million euro consulting projects and programmes in strategic management, operations, process optimisation and digital transition for large Energy and 0&G companies, E.g., enhanced recovery, asset optimisation, predictive maintenance and initiating digital programmes based on the famous buzz words AI and digital twin.

AND YOU JOINED C&S PARTNERS. WHY THIS CHANGE?

I was working for a large consultancy firm (about 80,000 people) and felt that the focus was more on shareholder expectations than on client's problems/solutions and relationships with them.
